Our Village Hall is in a very sound position. The buildings are in a very good state of repair, our financial position is also very healthy and we have had a record levels of groups and individuals booking our halls. We have been able to update our PA system as well as purchasing other various items, including new tables and chairs for both the Jubilee and Committee rooms. This prompted a review of our contents insurance which we have now increased.

At the start of year we were awarded Hallmark 2 status and immediately commenced work on Hallmark 3 which is the highest quality standard for community buildings. We achieved this by the end of this financial year.

In April we celebrated the 100 year anniversary of the commencement of our Community building with a tea party which was open to any parishioner to attend.
